

ARES/RACES

Registration Information Packet

This packet will give you the information you need to register with the Clark County Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) and Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service (RACES). Please follow the steps below:

Step

- 1. Read through the enclosed ARES/RACES brochure to get an idea of what ARES/RACES is all about. If you think you would like to be involved, then continue with Step 2.
- 2. Fill out the enclosed ARES/RACES Registration/Update Form and present it to your ARES Emergency Coordinator (EC) at this meeting or at the next meeting you attend.
- 3. Fill out the enclosed Volunteer Emergency Worker Registration Form and return it to your EC. He/she will submit it to the County Department of Emergency Services. Your EC will also arrange to have an ID photograph of yourself taken. After the form is processed, you will be given a State Emergency Worker ID card, which will have your photograph on it. You may have to present this ID card to authorities involved in an emergency or disaster (including training exercises). **All applicants are subject to a background check.**
- 4. After you receive your ARES ID card, meet with the ARES/RACES Training Officer and obtain a current Operations & Training Manual insert. Enclosed with this packet is information on how to assemble your Training Manual. You will also want to obtain a gold colored cap and an ARES patch for it. Cost of the patch is \$3.00 plus .50 for S & H.
- 5. By the next meeting you will be assigned to a team and will be introduced to your Team Leader.
- 6. Read Section 1 of the Training Manual before the next meeting.

It is expected that you will attend a reasonable number of ARES/RACES meetings that are held on the third Monday of each month (except August and December) at 7:00 PM at the location announced on the Clark County ARES website:

You are invited to check into the ARES and Information Net each Tuesday evening at 7:00 PM on the 147.24+ MHz repeater.
